Culligan Water Conditioning is now operating out of the Sedars Auto Park on Mason City's west side. Using the design-build concept, Henkel and Accörd Architecture, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Henkel, teamed up to create a spacious, highly efficient facility.

By combining their two locations, the \$950,000 building not only provides a unified location for their services, but also has a significant savings in energy costs. Truck access has also been improved. The structure is designed to allow trucks to drive through the building for loading and unloading purposes.

The 15,000 square foot facility has a white painted precast concrete exterior making an attractive backdrop for the large Culligan wave logo, clearly visible from Highway 122. Glass block was also used in the plant area allowing the flow of natural light.

Henkel erected the building and continued working through the 2000-2001 winter, one of the harshest on record, allowing Culligan to open right on schedule.
