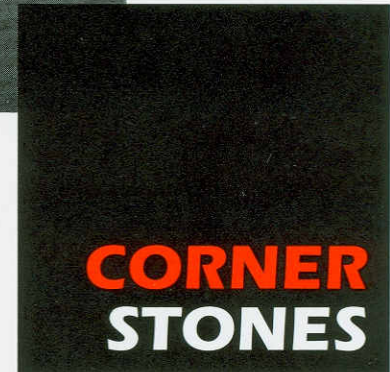


Door Frame Manufacturing Facility for Curries Company Completed

February 25, 1994, Henkel Construction Company completed work on the new \$6,500,000 Door Frame Manufacturing Facility for Curries Company of Mason City, Iowa. The new facility, located at 1600 12th Street N.W. in Mason City, symbolizes the commitment and vision of the Curries Company and the Mason City community toward the reinvigoration of North Iowa.

The new 218,000 square foot building, designed by Accord Architecture, covers five acres of land. Building components include a steel frame, precast concrete walls, and a single-ply rubber membrane roof. On the south side of the building, which is most visible from the road, the architects have utilized two different finishes on the same material to create interest on the vast walls and to emphasize the front entry.

Two ponds encompassing nearly three acres occupy the large open expanse between the building and the street. Prairie grass has been planted in this big open area to give a native prairie look and provide for wildlife habitat.

Curries began manufacturing steel doors and frames in Mason City in 1958. Today they produce a complete line of quality pre-engineered and custom steel doors and frames, which they market throughout the United States and internationally. Henkel has had the opportunity and challenge to grow with Curries over the years. Henkel has built all Curries' expansion projects since their inception.
