First Citizens National Bank of Mason City recently looked to Henkel Construction for their design-build capabilities in constructing their new drive-in facility in Mason City, Iowa.

The first phase of the project began in June with Henkel Construction demolishing a quarter city block at State Street and Delaware Avenue. Great care had to be taken to preserve the two remaining buildings on site.

The structure will feature four teller stations, loan offices, personal banking offices and a conference room. Included on the site will be four drive-in lanes as well as on-site customer parking.

The roof combines EPDM roofing with blue architectural metal roofing reminiscent of the main bank building located at Highway 18 West, as well as blending with the nearby Southbridge Mall. The exterior will consist of brick and EIFS walls.

Henkel has recently assisted First Citizens National Bank with several other projects: Accommodations for new data processing systems in the Clarion and Latimer offices; and a major remodeling in the Osage branch to include two additional drive-in lanes.

The project is scheduled for completion by December 1, 1996.
